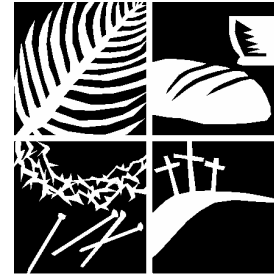

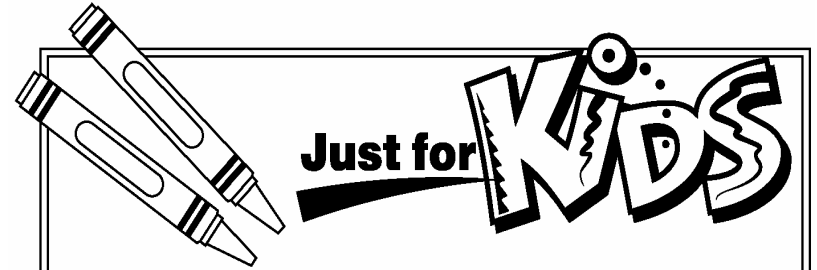

Dear Friends in Christ,

I hope you still love me. ☺

April Fools Day holds a special place in my heart each year, because my dear-departed Mom **ALWAYS—ALWAYS—ALWAYS—**tricked me on April Fools Day—and it didn't matter **HOW HARD** I tried to prepare myself for her—she **ALWAYS** got me.

It's a special blessing for me that we can celebrate our Lord's triumphant entry into Jerusalem on this day in the life of our world. We—the world—and all our understanding of what it meant to be King of Kings and Lord of Lords was tested, tried, and then surprised us. Let me share with you some other wonderful blessings & surprises God has given us this month in our life of faith together:

*At our **leadership retreat**, faithful servants developed a flow chart for communicating our ministries – so that all of us can have more ways to understand how we can serve our Lord in our congregation (*watch for more on this as it develops*). We also scheduled a **SECOND** leadership retreat for this summer. We have empowered, Spirit-filled leadership in this place that is ready and willing to grow!

*Kellie Brouse and Ed Coup have accepted God's call to seek training as **Authorized Lay Worship Leaders** in our synod. Council has unanimously recommended them, and they are in the process of completing their applications. God's blessings, Kellie and Ed!

*I will be meeting with Bishop Main on March 27 to talk about where we go next in the **call process**. My 2-year term call via the Synod Council is completed in Sept., and now we have the blessing of discerning whether this call is one God is leading us to share for the long-term. During these next months, Bishop Main will guide us through that process.

*We have the blessing of **new staff members** who have joined us. *Brett Hosterman* is a wonderful minister of music as our new organist. We will welcome him officially in our worship on Sunday, March 25. *John VanKirk* joins us as our new custodian. He began his ministry on March 13 and is in the process of being oriented to this new position. John also serves as part-time custodian at First Lutheran, Watsontown. *Bob Greenly* has accepted the call to serve as our new groundskeeper and will be offering his time and talent as a volunteer. What a blessing it is to have received so much joy in our life together!

Our **Staff Support** Ministry Group has been hard at work discerning God's call in our staffing needs. I am grateful for all their hard work – and I ask your blessing upon them. Linda Shipman is still seeking employment in the Lock Haven area, commuting to us three days a week to serve as our office manager. Staff Support will be discerning Linda's replacement in the near future – that will be another commitment of time and prayer. Linda has been a faithful servant who will be difficult to replace.

*Our **Stewardship** Ministry Group is up and running with all kinds of creative and helpful ideas. They are already hard at work sharing those blessings God has given them. Please prayerfully respond as God speaks to you through their ministry.

*Our **youth** are organizing and planning their ministry for the next year. They will be meeting the evening of April 15 under the faithful direction of Larry and Barb Gray. It has been exciting to see their excitement and energy!

*Our **confirmands** will soon be confirming their faith (5 have chosen to be confirmed on the Day of Pentecost, May 27). It has been a blessing to see how they have grown together, how they have enjoyed connecting with their mentors, and how God continues to strengthen their journey of faith.

As we come together again during Holy Week and celebrate our Lord's triumphant entry into overcoming death with life...will you join with me in giving thanks for God's great love in our Lord, Jesus? The many gifts we have come from that love God showers upon us each day. May you know that special love on Sunday, April 1 – and in the midst of your April fools – and every day: love that fooled the world – once and for all – with joy that never ends.

They were not only hungry for food, but also for this youth activity. The energy of all the kids was amazing! They had a terrific time playing together and gathering future

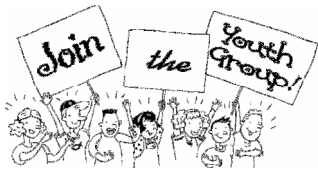
ideas to serve the church. All of them have definite leadership qualities and are tremendous examples of God’s children at work.

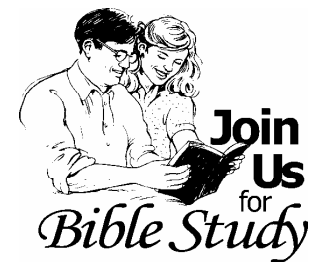
