- In June, please join your church family for a **Celebration of Children** on Sunday, June 22. Pastor Pat will be planning for children's participation in this service as we gather to celebrate the young disciples Jesus has given us. Don't miss this special day!

Every season is a delight – every day is another opportunity to give thanks and praise to our Lord. Think about ways the Lord might be calling you to participate in our summer ministries. 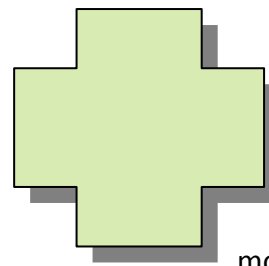

A reminder will be printed in the bulletin each week about the following week's lesson.

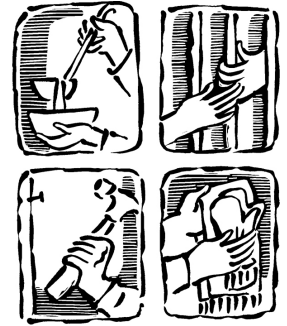

If you can open your home to our visitors for use of a shower, you are needed, too!

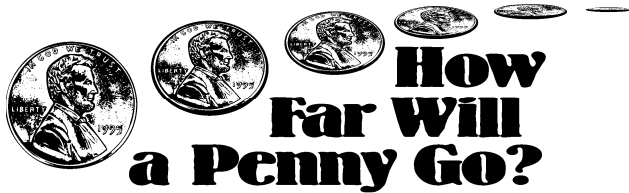
If you can provide food and presence at a “we welcome you” potluck dinner on Wednesday evening, July 30, 6:00 p.m., you are needed, too!

Congregation Council Meeting Highlights - May 6, 2008

Veteran's recognition is May 25, graduate recognition is June 8, Setting 5 from With One Voice will begin on June 1, joint services with Trinity begins June 1, Saturday night services begin June 7, Father's Day celebration is June 15, and Land and Seasons will be July 15. Also, new acolyte robes were chosen and ordered for use this Fall. A pianist is still needed for Saturday night services this summer season.



Pastor Pat will attend Region 8 Global Mission Event in Camp Hill, May 24 and participate in continuing education beginning May 25 (after worship) through June 2 in New Hampshire with a personal study of the kings of Israel and Judah.

Pam Walsh and Nancy Mensch are working together to provide summer Sunday School for children at 9 a.m. beginning June 1 through August 31. All ages will be combined and read together various Bible stories with activities that support the stories. Pam and Nancy are also willing to discuss co-chairing our Christian Education team. Vacation Bible School is scheduled for Sunday, July 13, through Thursday, July 17, from 5:30 to 8:30 each evening with a simple meal provided for the children who attend.

Council talked about ways of possibly bringing attention to the current deficit and ideas of helping the congregation to be aware of their current giving in comparison to past giving.

A donation of \$500 from current expenses will be donated to First Lutheran Church, Altoona, as a memorial gift in memory of Pastor Fred Romig.

Property committee recommended that the old sanctuary lights and possibly ceiling fans be donated to HUF.

The yard sale on Saturday, May 3, was a success with approximately \$250 collected with a match from Thrivent.

“Healthy” Spirituality

While studying elderly people and their immune systems, Duke University scientists discovered that senior adults who attend worship regularly have healthier immune systems than those who don't attend regularly.

And at the University of California, Los Angeles, a study showed that college students who participate in religious activities have better emotional and mental health than those with no religious involvement. A high degree of spirituality correlated with high self-esteem.

Participating in worship and other church activities appears to boost not only your spiritual health but also your physical and mental health. Make a commitment to stay involved – even in the busy summer months.
